  - 1.1. Canoeing is an assumed risk water contact sport. Participants should be aware of and willing to accept the inherent risk of accidents & injury involved. They should be prepared to assume personal responsibility for their own actions and involvement.
  - 1.2. Neither the Canoe Association of Northern Ireland, nor Canoe Ireland are under any liability whatsoever in respect of any personal injury or death, nor loss of or damage to personal property unless caused by proven negligence or default on their part or that of their suppliers or agents whilst attending the symposium.
  - 1.3. In the circumstances of cancellation of the event by the organisers, any liability shall be limited to the original fees paid. No liability whatsoever is accepted for consequential losses resulting from such a cancellation.
  - 1.4. The Symposium is endorsed by Canoe Association of Northern Ireland and is covered by their insurance. This comprises public liability cover for the event & all coaches working on it.
2. Health & Safety Considerations
  - 2.1. The Canoe Association of Northern Ireland reserves the right to modify or cancel advertised workshops due to safety considerations or other factors beyond their control.
