


# Safeguarding Requirements for British Canoeing Coaches and Leaders

Identify the steps required by 30th September 2020 to maintain Update status.



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**Note A** Your training can be interactive or eLearning. The course will need to provide a certificate or record of attendance. Evidence should be uploaded to your membership record for verification (not required if you complete the 'British Canoeing Introduction to Safeguarding Training'). Example titles include 'British Canoeing Introduction to Safeguarding', 'Safeguarding for Coaches'.

**Note B** Choose the most appropriate training to update your Safeguarding knowledge from time to time, providing evidence of doing so every 3 years as a minimum requirement. See the 'British Canoeing Safeguarding Training Policy for Coaches and Leaders' for more guidance.

**Note C** This could be face to face or in a digital classroom/interactive learning (eLearning is not suitable for this purpose). Your safeguarding training should be at least 3 hours duration (2.5 hours for UK Coaching online interactive course). The course will need to provide a certificate or record of attendance.

- The full Safeguarding Training policy is available from your National Association website.
  - Regardless of the expiry date given by the training provider British Canoeing requires update/ renewal every three years. Evidence uploaded to your membership record for verification
  - Completing safeguarding training in your workplace or through an organisation (Scouts for example) may also be accepted. You will need to supply evidence of attendance from your employer/ organisation. This should confirm you attended, the training content and the duration of the training session. (If you work with Children or Adults at Risk, this should state a minimum of 3 hours training has been completed).
