

## RECALL NOTICE

**Published: 1st March 2024**

British Canoeing has been made aware of a product recall for a Jiuran Neoprene Life Jacket sold via the online marketplace, Amazon, presenting a serious risk of drowning. The product was advertised as a life jacket, but once purchased was identified as a buoyancy aid (which does not provide the same level of protection).

The product being recalled is a black vest-style personal flotation device with a centre zipper.

The product does not meet the requirements of the PPE Regulation 2016/425.
